

Why this guy?



- HighMark School Development
 - ✓ Since 2005, \approx 60 charter school facility projects in 15 states
 - ✓ \$500+ million deployed as facility developer
 - \checkmark 2.3 million SF of charter school space = 60 acres
- Prior: Largest charter school builder in the US
 - ✓ ≈ 400 new-builds & renovation; ≈ \$650 million in construction; 20 states
 - ✓ 5.6 million SF of charter school spaces = 128.5 acres



Using the word "estimates"

Discuss "targets." They demonstrate intention. Early estimates are irresponsible.

2. Flawed Thinking



Think like a business. Don't fear the profit.

3. Wrong Sizing

Under budgeting rent & **Over sizing** spaces

Target 15-20% for rent. **Target 65-75** SF/student.

4. Occupancy Assumptions



Assuming occupancy rights



Understand <u>that</u> zoning and codes matter.






Improper use of an attorney

9. No Reference Checks





Failing to check references Call, visit sites, interview <u>with</u> past clients, review documents, dig deeply.

10. Wrong Questions



Use **Beausoleil's** tactical and practical 4C's question sheet.

11. Denial – Presumed Malice






Failing to deal with or deliver bad news Information is neutral. Assume no malice. Shift targets.

12. No Backup Plan





Failing to have a backup plan

Keep a contingency plan until you have a guaranteed move-in date.



- 1. Targets not estimates
- 2. Think like a business
- 3. 65-75 SF; 15-20%
- 4. Zoning matters
- 5. Facts cost \$\$, take time
- 6. Others exert control

- 7. Follow the right order

- 9. Check references
- **10.Ask the right questions**
- **11.Deal with reality**
- 12. Have a backup plan
